### LEAVE A LEGACY... WITH A PLANNED GIFT

Through a planned gift, you can continue to support the programs that are important to you. With your contribution, more lives will be touched.

#### WAYS TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE:

- A bequest in your will or trust. Sample wording for such a bequest might be: "I give, devise, bequeath to Interfaith Community Services, an Arizona nonprofit corporation located in Tucson, Arizona, 85741 (insert a dollar amount or percent of estate or a description of an asset) to be used to support this human services organization."
- A beneficiary designation on a life insurance policy or a retirement plan asset like a 401(k), 403(b) or an IRA.
- A Charitable Gift Annuity, Charitable Remainder Trust, or Charitable Lead Trust. These require more planning but may offer greater tax advantages to the individual.

Donors are strongly encouraged to discuss gift planning decisions, including the effect of IRS rules and regulations, with their financial advisors and legal counsel.
