Golf day includes a noon shotgun start, an after-rounds Mexican buffet dinner, awards, silent auction and raffle. A patriotic opening ceremony will set the tone for the day, and hole-in-one prizes will include cars from Jim Click Automotive. Donations make a difference: a \$150 donation allows ICS to help 15 people with gas vouchers to go to work, \$600 pays the electric bill for 8 struggling households for a month, and \$1,000 pays for 50 prescriptions for people with significant health issues who cannot afford their medications.
