- Forks, Spoons and Napkins
- Electricity (please let us know if you have this need as soon as possible)
- Event marketing prior to event
- On-site signage at your vendor area (please provide us with a logo when submitting this vendor form in one of the following formats: full color .eps or high resolution .jpg)

Restaurant/Food/Beverage Partner to Provide

- Please provide an appetizer, dessert (or some sort of 1-2 bite food item) or beverage to serve up to 350 guests
- Equipment (chafing dishes, hotboxes, etc. or whatever is needed to transport and keep your food or beverage at temperature; bottles, kegs, tubs or other dispensing equipment)
- Server / Restaurant or Food Provider Representative *
- Set up your table and food or beverage by 5:30 pm breakdown at 9:30 pm
- Opportunity for ICS to place an event poster or save-the-date postcards at your restaurant advertising the event
- Singed and completed health permit form (ICS will provide and submit the form, as well as cover the permit fee)
- *If you can not provide a server but would still like to participate, we will assign a volunteer to your table and work with you to coordinate drop off or pick up of your food items for the event.
