Job Description:

Volunteers will be supervising children ages 1-10+ inside and outside while their mothers attend the monthly Single Mom Scholars meeting. Volunteers embody ICS values of Respect, Integrity, Compassion, Collaboration, and Innovation.

Job Details:

- Volunteers will supervise and engage with kids between the ages of 1-10+
- Time will be spent outside watching kids on the playground as well as spending time inside working on a crafts, coloring, etc.
- Art supplies and crafts will be supplied for indoor activities
- Outdoor playground onsite for use
- Light snacks will be provided
