



ICS Volunteer Job Description Home Repairs

Job Title: Home Repairs, reports to Home Sweet Home Coordinator

Program: Home Sweet Home

ICS offers a variety of Caregiving Services that help registered ICS recipients who are frail, ill or disabled live independently in their own homes, without the need for institutional care. ICS knows that independence is important to seniors and disabled adults who want to age in the comfort of home. Our volunteers provide essential support services that help accomplish this, while also providing important social contact that helps keep recipients healthy and connected.

Job Description:

Home Sweet Home volunteers in Home Repairs help with minor renovations in participant's homes. Volunteers embody ICS values of Respect, Integrity, Compassion, Collaboration, and Innovation.

Job Details:

- Volunteers are assigned repair jobs as requested by participants
- Once assigned, the volunteer goes to the participant's home to complete the task
- Volunteers should not climb ladders or perform tasks that are too physically demanding
- Report hours and any issues or concerns after assignment to the Home Sweet Home Coordinator.

Volunteer Qualifications:

- Ability to repair and maintain appliances and perform other minor home repairs
- Provide personal set of tools

Location: Participant's home

Time Commitment: Flexible Schedule; 2-3 hours per assignment
