Job Title: Food Collection Event Driver with lifting

Program: NW Food Bank

The ICS NW Food Bank is an essential need for hundreds of families in our community on a daily basis. The NW Food Bank is open 6 days a week from 8 am to 11 am and T/Th evenings from 5:00 to 6:30 pm. The Mobile Food Bank Truck distributes food directly 4 times/wk at sites of need.

This volunteer position reports to the Food Distribution Manager.

Job Description:

Occasional food collection events are offered at our faith communities and other partner sites throughout the year. The **Food Collection Event Driver** attends the collection events with the ICS van to receive food donations and returns the food to the NW Food Bank. Be on a team of drivers for these occasional events such as the Oro Valley Church of the Nazarene Souper Bowl Sunday collection.

Volunteers embody ICS values of Respect, Integrity, Compassion, Collaboration, and Innovation.

Job Details:

- Attend community events hosting food collections for ICS
- Drive ICS Food Bank Van to represent ICS at these special events, collect donated food and return to NW Food Bank. You can bring a friend, too!
- Load food into and out of van
- Coordinate details with Food Bank Distribution Manager and the Faith Community Outreach Coordinator.

Volunteer Qualifications:

- Must have a good driving record, a valid driver's license, and proof of current auto insurance
- Friendly, welcoming, and cooperative attitude
- Knowledge of ICS Food Bank and services also a plus
- Must be able to lift at least 30 lbs.
