



ICS Volunteer Job Description Transportation Van Driver Wheelchair Van with Lift, November to March

Job Title: Transportation Van Driver for Wheelchair Van with Lift

Program: Caregiving Senior Services.

ICS offers a variety of Caregiving Services including transportation to help registered ICS recipients who are frail, ill or disabled live independently in their own homes, without the need for institutional care. Transportation for registered ICS recipients provides transportation to-and-from a medical appointment, pharmacy, bank, post office, library, hairdresser, exercise class, etc. upon request. Van Driver volunteers report to the Transportation Coordinator.

Job Description:

Drive the ICS Wheelchair van on a weekday from November to March with one or more participants. Take participants to the grocery store, medical appointments, or other requested need. Only participants who can transfer themselves to the vehicle seat without assistance are registered for service. Volunteers embody ICS values of Respect, Integrity, Compassion, Collaboration, and Innovation.

Job Details:

- With the ICS wheelchair lift van, drive participants to a medical appointment, grocery store or other requested need. Assist with shopping by reaching items on shelves and bringing groceries to the home, as requested
- Drive on a weekday from November to March, 9 am to 1 pm or 1 pm to 4 pm
- Volunteers may be asked to push the wheelchair but do not lift a participant
- As requested, masks can be worn by participants and volunteers.
- Training of van operations is provided.

Volunteer Qualifications:

- Current driver's license and no moving violations in the last 3 years
- Willingness and understanding of driving a van with backup camera and operating a lift with participant on it
- Reliability with your scheduled commitments and patience working with seniors/disabled.
- Willingness to learn operations of a wheelchair lift

Location: Pick up van at NW Office at 2820 W Ina Rd. Drive to various locations

Time Commitment: 3 - 4 hours per trip; volunteer selects an availability time slot Monday - Friday, 9am - 1pm or 1pm - 4pm. Volunteers are assigned to a trip based on recipient need.
