Job Title: Volunteer Driver

Program: Caregiving Senior Services

ICS offers a variety of Caregiving Services that help registered ICS recipients who are frail, ill or disabled live independently in their own homes, without the need for institutional care. The Transportation program offers recipients free transportation to-and-from medical appointments, shopping, pharmacy, bank, post office, library and salon upon request. Volunteer drivers report to the Transportation Coordinator.

Job Description:

Drive participants in your personal vehicle to ICS approved destinations and back to their homes. Volunteers embody ICS values of Respect, Integrity, Compassion, Collaboration, and Innovation.

Job Details:

- Assist participants in and out of your vehicle; no lifting
- Assist in shopping (help reach items); may help carry packages into home as needed
- As requested, assist participants into medical reception area for their medical appointment or into other appointments
- As requested, masks can be worn by participants and volunteers

Volunteer Qualifications:

- Reliable vehicle with current registration and driver's license/ No moving violations
- Friendly attitude while driving and interacting with seniors
- Reliability with your scheduled commitments and patience working with seniors

Location: Various locations throughout Tucson

Time Commitment: 3 hours per trip; trips are typically done Monday-Friday between 9am and 4pm
