Job Title: Yard Work, reports to Home Sweet Home Coordinator

Program: Home Sweet Home

ICS offers a variety of Caregiving Services that help registered ICS recipients who are frail, ill or disabled live independently in their own homes, without the need for institutional care. ICS knows that independence is important to seniors and disabled adults who want to age in the comfort of home. Our volunteers provide essential support services that help accomplish this, while also providing important social contact that helps keep recipients healthy and connected.

Job Description:

Home Sweet Home Yard Work volunteers help ICS participants with minor yard work around their homes. Volunteers embody ICS values of Respect, Integrity, Compassion, Collaboration, and Innovation.

Job Details:

- Volunteer is assigned yard maintenance jobs as requested by participants
- Once assigned, volunteer travels to participant's home to complete the tasks
- Volunteers do not cut branches on tall trees
- Volunteers are asked not to use ladders or work at any heights
- Report hours and any issues or concerns after assignment to the Home Sweet Home Coordinator

Volunteer Qualifications:

- Experience with yard work and/or landscaping
- Ability to complete yard work tasks such as raking, cleaning, pruning, etc.
- Volunteers provide their own set of yard working tools
- Both English and Bilingual Spanish speaking volunteers needed

Location: Participant's home, outdoors

Time Commitment: Flexible schedule; 2-3 hours per assignment
