Why Pasta? Pasta is an easy meal to feed an entire family. 1 lb of pasta and a 24 oz can of sauce can feed a family of four for under \$4.

When? The entire month of February! We will accept donations for the competition from Wednesday, February 1 to Tuesday, February 28.

How do we get the pasta to ICS? The preferred method is to drop off at either the Northwest Food Bank (2820 W. Ina Rd) Monday-Friday from 9 am-4 pm and Saturday 8-11 am. We will also accept donation at the Eastside Mobile Food Bank Hub (8701 E. Old Spanish Trail) Monday-Friday from 9-11 am.
