



ICS Volunteer Job Description Mobile Meals Frozen Food Packer Thursdays

Job Title: Mobile Meals Packer, reports to Mobile Meals Coordinator

Program: Senior Services - Mobile Meals

ICS Mobile Meals volunteers provide frozen nutritious meals on Thursdays to adults 60+ or disabled adults who are unable to cook for themselves

Job Description:

Organize and pack frozen meals for approximately 50 mobile meals participants in preparation for driver pick up. Volunteers embody the ICS values of Respect, Integrity, Compassion, Collaboration, and Innovation

Job Details:

- Three Volunteers, a lead packer and “sides” packers are needed for a weekly commitment on Thursdays.
- Working in the Ina Road Food Bank, organize and package meals for a weekly delivery of Mobile Meals for approximately 50 participants, divided into 8 routes.
- Meals include frozen entrees, sides, and a loaf of bread/butter once a month.

- Light lifting, grocery bag size
- Packing and organizing skills
