



## ICS Volunteer Job Description Mobile Meals Route Driver

**Job Title:** Mobile Meals Route Driver, reports to Mobile Meals Coordinator

**Program:** Senior Services - Mobile Meals

ICS Mobile Meals volunteers deliver fresh nutritious meals each weekday to adults 60+ or disabled adults who are unable to cook for themselves

### **Job Description:**

Regular Route Driver delivers fresh meals to ICS participants in northwest Tucson once a week, or they can share a route and make their schedule driving 2-3 times a month. Volunteers embody the ICS values of Respect, Integrity, Compassion, Collaboration and Innovation.

### **Job Details:**

- Pick up meals at ICS Ina Road Food Bank or other facilities that we partner with and deliver it to approximately eight Mobile Meal participants
- Return containers back to the facility, except for drivers delivering on the GAP route which provides food in disposable bags
- Route rosters with participant address and information will be emailed ahead of time
- In person training provided

### **Volunteer Qualifications:**

- Will use personal vehicle for deliveries - must have a good driving record, a valid driver's license, and proof of auto insurance
- Must have patience and be comfortable interacting with seniors with various health conditions
- Be reliable and able to use GPS
- Ability to communicate via email

**Location:** 4 facilities with routes: ICS Food Bank on Thursdays, GAP Ministries, Brookdale Santa Catalina & Encompass Health M-F

**Time Commitment:** Regular routes are one day a week, Monday - Friday for about 2 hours; substitute drivers will be contacted to fill in when needed
